**VIA HAND DELIVERY**

To whom it may concern:

Please be advised that this is formal written notice that Plano Starfest Music Festival LLC d/b/a Starfest ("Starfest") is in breach of the July 21, 2017 License Agreement for the promotion and production of a music festival at the Oak Point Park and Nature Preserve, which was executed with the City of Plano. This is formal notice that the 20 day cure period contained in section 8.01(b) has been invoked.

Specific breaches of the License Agreement include the following:

- Section 3.03 — the City has not been provided at least 48 hours' notice of music artists prior to the making of any public announcement of the festival, and such artists have not been mutually agreed-upon;
- Section 4.01 — no Special Event Permit has been obtained at least 30 days prior to the festival occurring; and
- Section 4.05(b) — no Surety Bond in the amount of \$100,000 has been submitted at least 30 days prior to the festival occurring.

Unless cured within 20 days, the License Agreement is subject to termination by the City of Plano.
