Topic: Assault

8/5/19: Det. Allen was assigned this case.

8/5/19: Det. Allen took pictures of the location where the incident took place. Also went to 2570 Lone Star Dr. and retrieved video of the incident. Brian Loos, Dir of Warehousing, will email video to me by 8/9/2019. The video shows Mr. Vess charging DFR Cox into oncoming traffic. DFR Cox can be seen on BWC delivering a kick. Officers Hernandez and Ruiz BWC documents Complainant Vess in the hospital. He appears to be in and out of a coherent state and rambling throughout all video footage. In one video Officer Hernandez can be heard speaking with Complainant Vess' mother in which she revealed his right leg was broken a week prior to this incident. She further stated she had been attempting to contact the complainant, but all attempts were unsuccessful. At no point during the footage did Complainant Vess give a sustainable account of the details in the incident. At no time did he comply with officers' request for his personal information.

8/6/2019: Det. Allen contacted C. Garcia, DSO, and he will come down on 8/8/19 at 7am to interview. Sgt. Martin, DSO, will email BWC video from Officer Garcia BWC. Also, contacted Officers J. Cuddy and Z. Johnson and they both will come down to be interviewed on 8/9/19 at 9am.

8/7/19: Det. Allen spoke Kevin Vess, Father, about the care of his son who is the complainant. Mr. Vess informed Det. Allen that [REDACTED]

[REDACTED] Det. Allen informed Mr. Vess that the Public Integrity Unit would want to speak with the complainant when he became free to speak with us.

8/8/2019: Det. Allen interviewed Carmelo Garcia, DSO, and he was there to provide cover to for DFR. Officer Garcia assisted Officer Cuddy and Johnson in placing the complainant in handcuffs. Officer Garcia provided his BWC.

8/8/2019: Det. Allen made an attempt to interview Complainant Vess but was unable to because of his mental state.

8/9/2019: Det. Allen interviewed Officers Cuddy and Johnson who were both partners the day they came in contact with the complainant. Officer Cuddy stated she deployed the Taser on the complainant after the complainant was kicked in the head by DFR Cox. Officer Johnson did not witness the kick because he was getting rubber gloves to put on before coming in contact with the complainant. Officer Cuddy did report the kick to Sergeant Cruz #8042.

8/13/2019: Det. Allen interviewed Sgt. Cruz who was the responding supervisor at the scene.

8/15/2019: Det. Allen interviewed Mike Frisbee on the phone. Det. Allen was told by Mr. Vess that Mr. Frisbee had information about the arrest. Mr. Frisbee did not want to speak on the incident. Mr. Frisbee was given third party information on what he believed occurred at the arrest the information. Det. Allen was made aware of Mr. Frisbee by Mr. Vess. The two are friends.

Case turned in for review October 20190.

On 8-2-19 at approximately 12:54PM, the Police Dispatcher placed an assist Officer requested by DFR at 2700 DFW Turnpike on the Westbound Service Road. Officers arrived and Suspect Vess, Kyle, Robert W/M/[REDACTED] on AIS [REDACTED] was having an Excited Delirium episode. Suspect was combative and would not follow any verbal commands. He then calmed and was lying down on the pavement. When Sgt Cruz #8042 arrived, the Suspect was already in handcuffs, was being placed on the stretcher and was about to be transported to [REDACTED]

While at location, DSO Officer C. Garcia #1022 offered Sgt Cruz if he needed the BWC as evidence of what occurred, he would have it available. While Suspect was being transported to Hospital, Officer J. Cuddy #10515 called Sgt Cruz and advised that he needed to investigate her BWC because she observed Fire Fighter / Comp Brad Cox from station #36 kick the Suspect while he was sitting upright on the pavement. While still at location, Sgt Cruz spoke with Comp and he said he was punched in the face by Suspect right closed fist. The Comp refused medical treatment.

She also informed Sgt Cruz that she tazed the Suspect after he got kicked by the Comp. After Suspect was kicked, the Suspect got up from the pavement and chased Comp. After the Suspect was tazed, he calmed down and complied to verbal commands. Sgt Cruz and Lt. Jaquez #6969, after reviewing BWC footage called SIU and spoke with Sgt Woodham #8394. After speaking with SIU, Sgt Cruz and Lt. Jaquez went to [REDACTED] and spoke with Suspect Vess. Suspect advised he was kicked while on the ground and tazed. Suspect Vess had a black eye to his right eye, bloody nose, multiple fractures to his face and a swollen right ankle.

The conversation Sgt Cruz and Lt. Jaquez had with Suspect at [REDACTED] is on BWC of Officers J. Hernandez #10030 and R. Ruiz #1005. Officers located the Suspect mother by phone and advised her where the Suspect whereabouts. Sgt Cruz and Lt. Jaquez made contact with Sgt Williams from DSO and Officers were advised to come Monday 8-5-19 to get a copy of BWC footage. Assault to Public Servant Offense was generated on Case #155804-2019, PES took pictures of Comp and Susp and Chain of Command was advised.

Investigation:

On August 2, 2019, Sergeant Luis Cruz, #8042, Southwest Patrol Division, contacted the Public Integrity Unit to advise Police Officer Jessica Cuddy, #10515, Southwest Patrol Division, observed DFR Cox assault Complainant Vess.

Dallas Fire Rescue #38 responded to 2500 Dallas Fort Worth Turnpike service road on a grassfire. Surveillance video from the Pecan Deluxe Candy Factory captured DFR Cox standing in front of the fire engine with his arm extended toward Complainant Vess, as he stood near the smoky grass area. The surveillance footage captured Complainant Vess charge and attempt to strike DFR Cox. The altercation causes DFR Cox to eventually retreat into the roadway and out of the camera view.

The Body Worn Camera (BWC) footage documents Officers Cuddy, Zachery Johnson, #10516, Southwest Patrol Division, and Dallas Sheriff Officer (DSO) Carmelo Garcia, #1022, Traffic Unit, arrive and Complainant Vess is in the roadway waving his arm while DFR Cox facing him. DFR Cox can be heard instructing Complainant Vess to remain on the ground. Complainant Vess raised up, disregarded the verbal commands and turned toward DFR Cox. DFR Cox delivered one kick striking Complainant Vess in the upper torso. Complainant Vess immediately stood up and lunged toward DFR Cox. Officer Cuddy deployed her Taser one time at Complainant Vess causing him to fall to the ground. He then pulled the taser probes out and continued disobey all verbal commands. Subsequently, Complainant Vess was restrained.

On August 3, 2019, Detectives Allen and Luis Velazquez, #9953, interviewed Complainant Vess at the Lew Sterrett Justice Center. Detective Allen attempted to explain the nature of the visit; however, he did not appear to understand the intent. Complainant Vess rambled during the interview and was unable to articulate what occurred during his encounter with DFR Cox.



On August 9, 2019, Detective Allen interviewed Officer Cuddy in the Public Integrity Unit. Officer Cuddy stated she responded to the location and observed a large portion of burned grass adjacent to the service road. She recalled being advised Complainant Vess assaulted DFR Cox and he sustained minor injuries to the forehead and nose. Officer Cuddy stated Complainant Vess appeared to be intoxicated. Officer Cuddy stated as she and Officer Johnson waited for an additional element to assist with the arrest, Complainant Vess looked at DFR Cox. She explained DFR Cox kicked Complainant Vess. Complainant Vess immediately stood up and advanced toward DFR Cox. Officer Cuddy stated she deployed her Taser at Complainant Vess' buttocks and leg because he was wearing a backpack. She recalled Complainant Vess removed the probes and attempted to stand up again. Officer Cuddy stated Complainant Vess was eventually handcuffed and transported to [REDACTED]

Detective Allen interviewed Officer Johnson in the Public Integrity Unit. Officer Johnson stated upon their arrival he was approached by unknown firemen and advised Complainant Vess had assaulted DFR Cox. Officer Johnson stated he walked to the front of the fire engine and observed Complainant Vess lying on the road and mumbling. Officer Johnson stated, and unknown firemen offered him gloves. He then walked toward the fire engine and heard a Taser being deployed. Officer Johnson stated he quickly returned to the front of the fire engine and observed Complainant Vess on the ground. Officer Johnson stated he observed Complainant Vess sit up and he pointed his taser at him and gave loud verbal commands. Complainant Vess failed to comply with the commands and was eventually placed in handcuffs.

Conclusion:

Investigators were unable to ascertain specific elements of a criminal offense from Complainant Vess regarding his interaction with DFR Cox. All contact between law enforcement officers and Complainant Vess were documented via audio recordings and BWC. This investigation will be classified as closed and will be forwarded to the Dallas Fire Department Internal Affairs Division for an administrative review.

AFFIDAVIT IN ANY FACT

THE STATE OF TEXAS COUNTY OF DALLAS

BEFORE ME, Lee Allen, #7025, a Police Officer for the Dallas Police Department in and for said County, State of Texas, on this day personally appeared, Jessica Cuddy, #10515, after being by me duly sworn, on oath deposes and says: (WARNING: You are submitting the following statement under oath. Any untruthful statement given knowingly will subject you to possible prosecution for Perjury, 37.02, False Report to Peace Officer or Law Enforcement Employee, 37.08, or Tampering with or Fabricating Physical Evidence, 37.09).

My partner, Z. Johnson 10516, and I were dispatched to a P.D. request by Fire on 08/02/2019 at about 12:59PM. Upon arrival, I observed a large area of the grass on the service road had been burned and was black. My partner and I walked in front of the fire engine and observed that Arrested Person Vess was lying on the ground in the right lane, talking to himself and appeared to be intoxicated on an unknown substance.

I was told by DFR that Arrested Person Vess had fought one of the firemen. I asked which of the firemen had been assaulted. The firemen standing around Arrested Person Vess pointed to DFR Fireman Cox. I observed that DFR Fireman Cox had red marks on his forehead and nose. My partner and I were waiting for one more cover element to arrive to take Arrested Person Vess into custody. With the knowledge that Arrested Person Vess had already been very violent, I did not want to risk having too few officers to place him into custody while standing so closely to the freeway.

Within a few seconds, Arrested Person Vess sat up and looked at myself and my partner, who were standing in front of him. He then turned his head to look behind him where Fireman Cox was standing. Fireman Cox used his right leg to kick Arrested Person Vess while he was still seated. Arrested Person Vess immediately got up off of the ground and advanced on Fireman Cox to fight. I pulled out my taser and fired once into Arrested Person Vess' buttock and leg because Arrested Person Vess was wearing a backpack, which would have prevented the taser probes from making contact with his person.


The taser appeared to be effective because Arrested Person Vess staggered to the ground, but once the 5 seconds elapsed, Arrested Person Vess intentionally yanked the wires out of the taser probes. Arrested Person Vess then quickly tried to stand up again but observed my partner's taser pointed at him. Arrested Person Vess stayed seated instead and held up his middle fingers at my partner and I before lying back down on the

ground. DSO Officer Garcia 1022 moved in to handcuff Arrested Person Vess. I moved in quickly afterward and assisted in handcuffing Arrested Person Vess. I then pulled out the taser probes and once more cover arrived, we moved Arrested Person Vess to the side of the roadway. Arrested Person Vess continued to struggle with us even after placing him in handcuffs. He tried to bite and kick us while we tried to control him on the side of the roadway. We placed a pair of flexicuffs on Arrested Person Vess' legs so that he would not kick DFR while they assessed him prior to placing him in the ambulance. I then rode in the ambulance with DFR and Arrested Person Vess to [REDACTED]. During the ambulance ride, Arrested Person Vess was still cursing and trying to bite me.





On 8-2-19 at approximately 12:54PM, the Police Dispatcher placed an assist Officer requested by DFR at 2700 DFW Turnpike on the Westbound Service Road. Officers arrived and Suspect Vess, Kyle, Robert W/M [REDACTED] on AIS # [REDACTED] was having an Excited Delirium episode. Suspect was combative and would not follow any verbal commands. He then calmed and was lying down on the pavement. When Sgt Cruz #8042 arrived, the Suspect was already in handcuffs, was being placed on the stretcher and was about to be transported to [REDACTED]

While at location, DSO Officer C. Garcia #1022 offered Sgt Cruz if he needed the BWC as evidence of what occurred, he would have it available. While Suspect was being transported to Hospital, Officer J. Cuddy #10515 called Sgt Cruz and advised that he needed to investigate her BWC because she observed Fire Fighter / Comp Brad Cox from station #36 kick the Suspect while he was sitting upright on the pavement. While still at location, Sgt Cruz spoke with Comp and he said he was punched in the face by Suspect right closed fist. The Comp refused medical treatment.

She also informed Sgt Cruz that she tazed the Suspect after he got kicked by the Comp. After Suspect was kicked, the Suspect got up from the pavement and chased Comp. 
